



POCKET BLINKER, DEVICE 12WW

FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION:

The Pocket Blinker, Device 12WW, aids in teaching code and the reading of blinker signals.

The device is a small black cardboard envelope that fits into the palm of the hand; in the front of the envelope is a series of slits with a black background. Opening and closing of a blinker searchlight is imitated by pressing the fingers on the top of the envelope to change the black background in the slits to white, and then releasing the pressure to restore it to black. On the back of the envelope is a list of International Morse Code Signals.
