



HAND SEMAPHORE TRAINER, DEVICE 12WW2

FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION:

The Hand Semaphore Trainer, Device 12WW2, assists in the teaching of code and semaphore signals.

This device provides simulated self-training for one (1) man or practice for two (2) men located 5' to 10' from each other. The trainer is a cardboard and plastic, pocket-size device which dynamically demonstrates sending and receiving the semaphore (wig-wag) alphabet.

DESIGN:

The device consists of a single-fold cardboard cover with front and back views of a sailor without arms on the front and back of the folder, respectively. The front and back of the folder are perforated to show the arm and flag positions for the various letters through openings. Flag and arm positions are printed on a rotating, circular, saw-tooth-edge, plastic disc fastened in the folder. Letters of the alphabet are printed on the edge of the disc. As the plastic disc is rotated, one (1) letter at a time appears in an opening at the bottom of the device, and the corresponding arm and flag positions appear above.
